Featured Guest Artist - Nancy Duesing Takaichi



Nancy is an award-winning Plein Air painter that will be joining us to discuss this technique which blends creativity and nature.

Nancy was born in Cincinnati and majored in Art at DePauw University. She apprenticed for New York artists Jack Bealand and Jane Frelicher. She interned at Fischbach Art Gallery and Franklin Furnace Art Books. Nancy had a 30-year career in high tech as a corporate events planner, marketing communications, and newsletter editor. She returned to painting in 2012 and is represented by Gallery 24 in Los Gatos, CA.

Artist's Statement

I'm hooked on plein air painting. There is an immersion that happens by being in the scene- the light, the air, the sounds and the scene itself envelope me. It is immediate and I can intimately react to not just what I see, but what I know to be true. I'm not interested in panoramic scenes; I want to parcel it down to what portion of the scene speaks to the enormity of it. I look for the story of what makes this place unique, and so often it is about the light. Living in Northern California, sunlight is a big part of any scene I paint and is a fascination of mine. I'm also interested in subject matter that is in transition. Weather seasonal, or permanent changes caused by development, I feel compelled to record history in paint.
